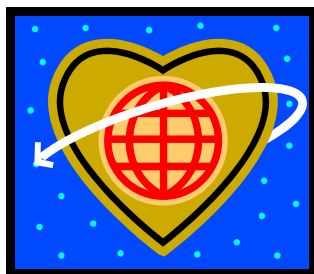

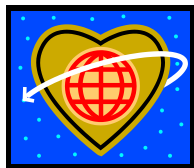

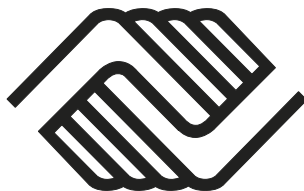
## Club Dollars, Field Trips & Club Store
