## HOW WE'RE FUNDED

BGCMC's budget was **\$4.2 million** in 2014-15 and is expected to grow annually as more sites are launched. Major funding sources include Foundations/Grants, Individuals/Bequests, and Fundraising Events like Comics for Kids, Golf for Kids, and Opportunity Drawing.

We are dependent on the generosity of our community to sustain our programs; fees and contracts only make up 20% of our budget. We truly couldn't do this work without the support of our investors.

# **ENRICHING THE LIVES OF YOUTH**

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Monterey County believes that by enriching the lives of youth in a meaningful way, we can make a lasting, positive impact on children and families in our community. Members are guided by youth development professionals who receive over 130 hours of training annually. We are committed to providing a Club experience that includes: a Safe, Fun, Positive Environment; Supportive Relationships; Recognition, Opportunities and Expectations.

BGCMC goes beyond providing after-school care by offering "expanded learning" programs designed to support academic success and inspire a love of learning. Our staff and volunteers work together to offer members the support, guidance and resources they need to maintain on-time grade progression and graduate high school with a plan for their future.

#### \*KEY OUTCOMES:

95% of members are on grade level for age 87% of youth expect they will complete college 85% of members believe school to be important **79%** of members did not miss a single day of school 87% of Career Expo attendees came away with a clear idea of the career they want to pursue and how to achieve it



Guided by our nationally recognized Nutrition Policy, our kids learn how to be healthy by eating right and participating in daily fitness activities. And, we support positive life choices by offering workshops on topics that are most important to our youth, including drug prevention, gang aversion, healthy relationships, and careers.

#### \*KEY OUTCOMES:

69% of members engage in physical activity 5-7 days/week 91% of teen members abstained from drinking 93% of teen members abstained from drug use 94% of teen members abstained from sexual activity
