Club & Community Impact

- 1,397 Youth participated in Summer Programs & Activities!
- Programs were offered at 3 sites Seaside and Salinas
 Clubhouses and La Gloria Elementary School in Gonzales.
- 28,021 nutritious meals & snacks were served.
- 7 Club Teens completed a paid Summer Internship.
- 100% of Members received a minimum of 60 minutes of physical activity daily.
- 487 Youth attended one of 17 field trips opportunities.




PCS Edventures & Project Based Learning



8 weeks of PCS Edventures positively impacted Members' attitudes about the STEAM disciplines (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics). Each curriculum was tailored towards a specific grade group and allowed Members to communicate, collaborate, problem solve and adapt. Middle and high school Members created roller coasters and engineered amusement park rides with K'NEX, while elementary members worked together to build American symbols like the flag and the liberty bell, structurally sound homes for the "Three Little Pigs" and how to build things to scale with Lego Bricks. These hands on opportunities allowed our Members to flourish this summer while engaging in the STEAM disciplines.

Adventures in STEAM Program

- 98% of Members demonstrated improvement in key p21 skills such as Collaboration & Communication, Initiative & Self Direction, Critical Thinking & Problem Solving, Flexibility & Adaptability and Productivity & Accountability.
- 100% of the project teams presented at the S.T.E.A.M. Fairs at both Clubhouses which provided members the opportunity to showcase their projects and share their adventures with the community.
- 92% of reviewed journal entries by members reported they had fun and learned something new and challenging during these activities.
