

DIY Dominoes

Supplies Needed:

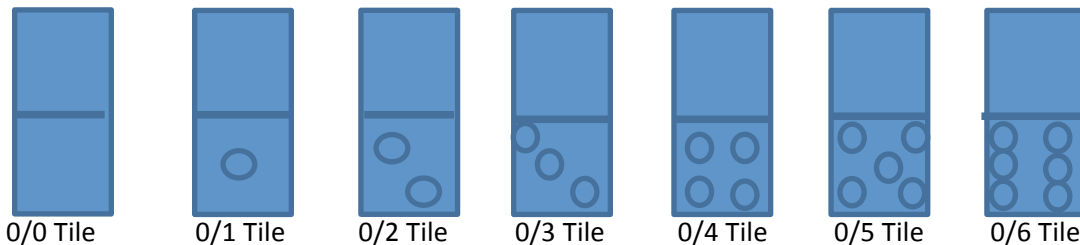
- 14 pieces of blank paper
- Scissors
- Marker/ Pencil

How to Make: (follow the bullet points from top to bottom for perfect Domino pieces)

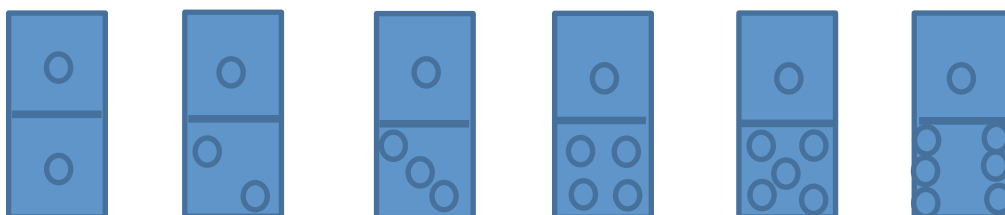
- Fold each piece of paper in half hamburger style
- Cut each piece of paper along the line in which the fold made
- You should have 28 pieces of paper
- Next grab a marker or pencil
- Now you will need to draw a line through each paper so it looks like this:



- For this next step we will learn about the numbers used in dominoes. 0 through 6 are used as the number system. Each tile(piece) has two numbers on each side which are marked by dots
- We'll start with the 0 tiles
- Grab 7 pieces of paper, the top half of the paper will be left blank to represent 0 dots. The bottom half of the papers draw a dot starting with 1 and going to 6, there will be one with nothing on it to represent 0. There will be one number per paper(view example below)(Make it look prettier)

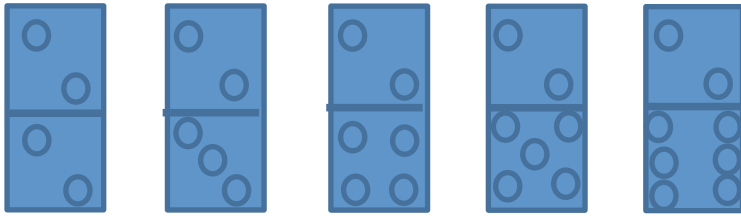


- Next grab 6 pieces of paper, on the top half of each paper make one dot with the marker
- On the bottom half of the papers draw a dot starting with 1 and going to 6 (view example below)

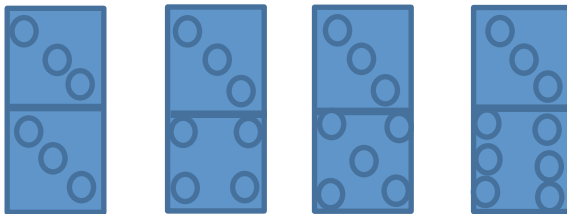


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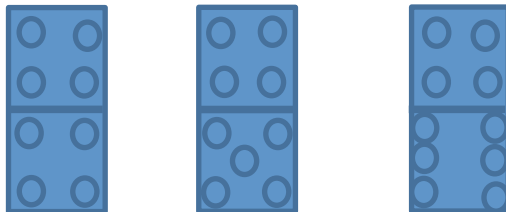
- Next grab 5 pieces of paper, on each paper on the top half make two dots, on the bottom half make a dot for the numbers 2 through 6(view Example below)



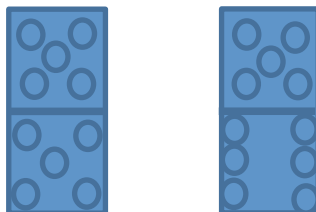
- Next grab 4 pieces of paper, on the top half of each paper make three dots with the marker, on the bottom half make a dot for the numbers 3 through 6(view example below)



- Next grab 3 pieces of paper, on the top half of each paper make four dots with the marker, on the bottom half make a dot for the numbers 4 through 6(view example below)



- Next grab 2 pieces of paper, on the top half of each paper make five dots with the marker, on the bottom half make a dot for the numbers 5 and 6(view example below)



- Grab the last piece of paper, on both halves you are going to make six dots
