BY THE NUMBERS

- **OVER 2,000** Monterey County youth and families were provided with resources and support
- 800 YOUTH participated in the Club's new virtual program platform, Virtually BGCMC
- 612 OUTREACH KITS were provided to youth through distribution sites across Monterey County
- 14 TEENS & ALUMNI held a paid internship through the Club or with a partnering organization

NUTRITION SUPPORT



- 19,384 NUTRITIOUS MEALS AND SNACKS SERVED to youth attending the Salinas and Seaside Clubhouse, as well as five low-income housing communities in Marina, Seaside, and Soledad.
- 5,600 FRESH PRODUCE BOXES TOTALING 8,400 POUNDS WERE DISTRIBUTED as a Farmers to Families USDA Food Box Partner, BGCMC provides 400-600 fresh produce boxes weekly to underserved families. Produce boxes contents include: 2lb bags of chopped romaine lettuce, 3 bags of apple slices, russet potatoes, onions, 2 lb bag of stone fruit

peaches/plums, and 1lb bag of tomatoes. There are 15 distribution locations throughout Monterey County.

BACK TO SCHOOL

- Following all guidelines we'll be able to serve up to 150 youth daily in our Clubhouses
- 50 staff completed a total of 1,200 hours of safety protocol training to ensure that our Clubs operate in the safest way possible.
- The full day on-site Clubhouse program (7:30am-4:00pm) assists students while they attend classes during distance learning by providing academic support, enrichment opportunities, breakfast, lunch, and snacks. We continue to offer College & Career Readiness programming to middle and high school students. Read Naturally supports youth that are reading below grade level.
