Q2. Where do campers check-in?

Look for the Johnson-Toney Football Camp signs as you approach the stadium's main entrance.

Q3. Is walk up registration available during the football camp?

Yes. If space is available, campers can sign up at the late registration table.

Q4. Tell me about the coaches

Over 40 experienced volunteer coaches at the Johnson-Toney Football Camp will teach campers fundamental skills. All coaches are background-checked, with many having athletics and fitness expertise. Some coach at youth, high school, or college levels, and a few current and former NFL players will be on hand to share their insights.

Q5. Is this a non-contact football camp?

Yes, this is a non-contact football camp where coaches emphasize proper techniques at all times. Campers will learn stance, starts, route running, catching, passing, blocking, guarding, and basic offense and defense. Campers will also participate in scrimmage games daily.

Q6. Should campers bring any special equipment?

Rubber cleats or cross-training shoes provide the best footing on natural grass. Water bottles are allowed but not required. Campers receive a t-shirt and lightweight backpack with apparel generously donated by adidas.

Q7. What should campers wear to the football camp?

Campers are expected to wear their camp-issued t-shirt every day. Please do not alter the t-shirt by writing on it, tearing sleeves, etc. Campers provide their own shorts or sweatpants, gloves, and cleats.

Q8. Is there anything campers should not bring to camp?

Yes. Please do not bring valuables to the camp.

Q9. Is there a picture day?

Yes. Campers will take a full group picture on Thursday.

Q10. Is lunch provided?

Yes. A free lunch is provided all four days of camp. Water stations are available on all fields and near food service areas. Meals are served near the stadium.

Q11. Will my child/children practice with other campers in their age range?

Yes. The three age ranges are: 9-11-year-olds, 12-14-year-olds, and 15-17-year-olds.

Q12. Can parents, friends and family watch practice?

Yes, spectators are welcome to watch from a safe distance away on the sidelines.

Q13. Where should I park?

June Camp: There is a daily \$5 fee for parking on the CSUMB campus. Parking passes may be obtained at designated pay stations in the parking lot.

July Camp: Free parking is available on the scoreboard side at Rabobank Stadium. Enter from Maryal Drive.

Q14. Is transportation available for campers?

Yes. Free transportation is available. See schedules below.
